THE RACE

Starting at 12:00 Noon on July 30th, the first boat leads the "inverted start" fleet on a 17 mile course over the waters off Channel Islands and Ventura Harbors. A Bar-B-Que and trophy presentation will take place at the Pacific Corinthian Yacht Club following the race. Trophies will be awarded in each class and for overall winners with the first to finish skipper also receiving his weight in Mumm's Champagne.

Friday night, prior to the race, there will be a free Taco Bar.
