Life Aquatic is a 74-foot Hatteras owned by Robert and Angie Alexander. The Alexanders have an impressive boating resume. They have cruised the Gulf Coast via the Inner Coastal Waterway (ICW). Further east, Florida, the Keys, and the Caribbean. In addition to that most of the Great Lakes, the Mississippi and Missouri rivers. When their four girls were very young they cruised aboard their catamaran to Mexico including Zihuatanejo and the Sea of Cortez. In all they have owned 15 boats.

All this impressive experience and boating knowledge got them to their present boat Life Aquatic. Those young girls have grown and started families of their own. Life Aquatic is the

perfect yacht to accommodate their daughters, two sons-in-law and four grandchildren while cruising the Southern California bight.

Dear Fellow Club Members:

As an update on the development of our Junior Fleet, I am pleased to report that Mr. Juan Castro donated a fully functional Catalina (Capri) 14.2 sailboat to help support the program - the boat is now in our boatyard. Many thanks to Commodore Robert Alexander for helping to tow it in, and we are grateful to Mr. Castro for his generous donation.

Because we will have this boat soon available for families and kids to experience the famed trade winds of the Channel Island Harbor, I looked up what I could find about it on the web. Capri 14.2s are frequently used for family cruising and in some areas as an excellent one-design racing boat since there are many of these boats around. It is easy to set up and easy

to learn to sail in light to moderate winds. Importantly, the mast height is below the bridge (!) so one need not worry about dismasting in the middle of the channel, although being a center-board design it can capsize but (supposedly) can be righted up easily (full-body ocean dunking required). I am sure we will find out how to do it soon enough. You can read more about the boat and the history at the link <https://whichsailboat.com/2015/07/22/catalina-14-2/>

I am hopeful that its simplicity will make it attractive for our members with kids to quickly get on the water at our club. I look forward to putting this boat on the water in the next month or two and will be calling on volunteers to help with a few chores to get it ready - clean up, assemble, etc. If you are interested, please let me know.

Your application needs to be received by 12:00 noon on Wednesday, May 16, 2024.

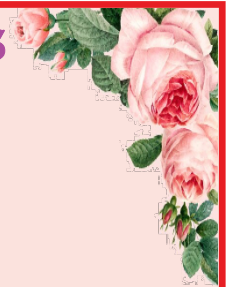

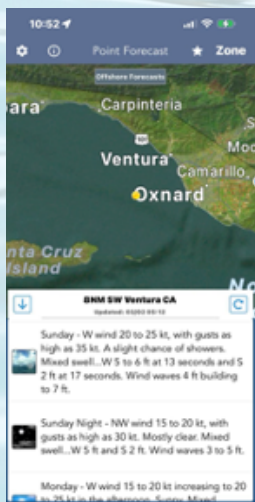

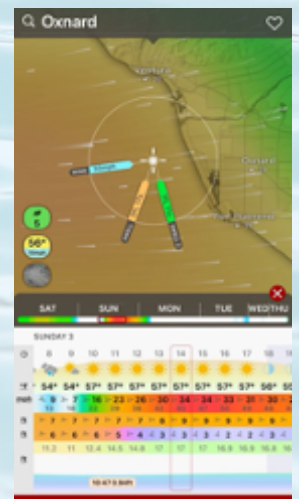
Another Sail Race Cancelled! Weather and safety on the water are directly related. Both TGIS Winter Series #1 and #2 so far have been cancelled due to severe weather in the Channel Islands sailing area.



As the Race Committee (RC) Chairman, I personally enjoy designing the Race Courses NOT cancelling a race due to weather; however, this is an RC function and vital for safety in the conduct of a sail race.

The RC monitors weather conditions in the weeks prior to a race using several methods: 1) Observing weather conditions from the deck at Bill's Bar while sipping on a cocktail. 2) Listening to weather

reports on local Coast Guard weather channels. 3) Using software applications such as NOAA and Windy. On the left, a screenshot of the NOAA App and right, a Windy screenshot. Both showing forecasts for March 3, 2024. 4) The last method is also important!

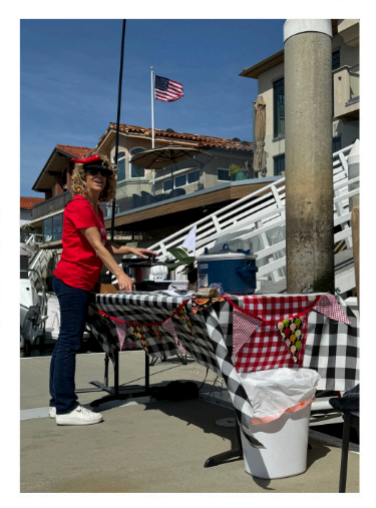
