

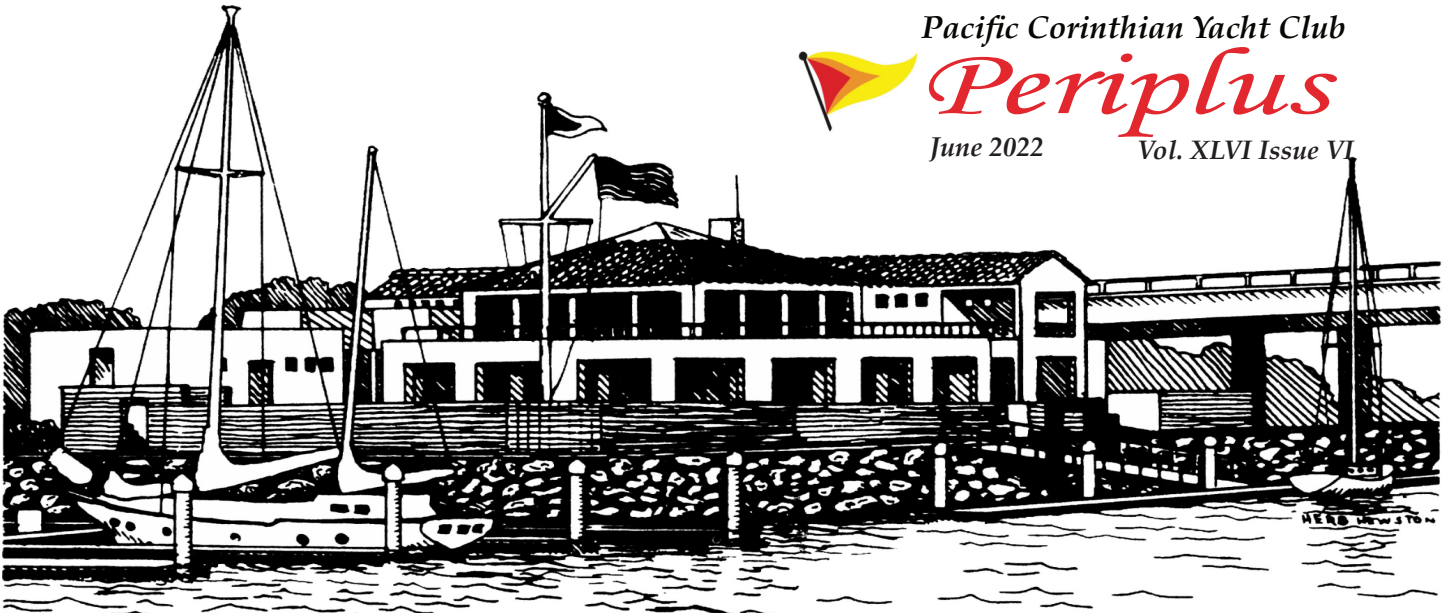

Meaning of Periplus

The word periplus stems from Greek, meaning 'journey' and also means a circumnavigation or sea voyage around a coastline. The use of a periplus, or journal, dates back to the second century and was a document listing in order, the ports and coastal landmarks, with approximate intervening distances, that the captain of a vessel could expect to find along a shore. In that sense the periplus was a type of log, similar to the modern day ship's log.

We use the term for our Club newsletter since it is the documentation of our travels at the Club and offshore and provides a historical record for us to reminisce and share with others. It is our shared and unique history as club members.

- (e) Board interest

You are not eligible to serve on this Nominating Committee if you have served on the Nominating Committee in the last year. However, Staff Commodores may serve two (2) years in a row.

By serving on this Committee, you will be making a very important contribution to PCYC.

CLUBHOUSE RULE NOTIFICATION

On May 19, 2022, the Board of Directors approved the following amended version of Clubhouse Rule #11:

11. Business Transactions – No member, spouse, registered domestic partner, or co-applicant, if any, may use the on-line membership roster information or the Club PCYC ROSTER for the purpose of soliciting any business, or use the Club in any way for commercial gain. Well, It's June and the sea bass and halibut are in full speed! If you can get out there, fish are all around Santa Cruz and Santa Rosa Island. Find the squid bed and set up on it, that's the easiest way to get bit or you can meter the sea-bass. There are many schools around.

If you don't have live squid you can use fresh dead or the other bait that is working well is the 7 1/2 inch white fluke bait with a 1 to 1 1/2 oz leadhead. Recently Santa Barbara Island has been seeing some nice quality yellowtail and sea bass. That island can be a little fickle but always worth a look.

At this time, middle of May writing the article, Justin Lostutter has a 47 inch white sea-bass that is 35 pounds! An awesome fish. Don Clark has a 32 inch halibut and a 46 inch sea-bass .Both have a first place fish at this time. There is still plenty of time if you'd like to sign up for our Summer Slam Tournament, we fish until mid October.

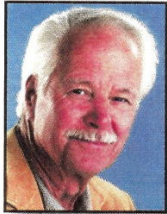

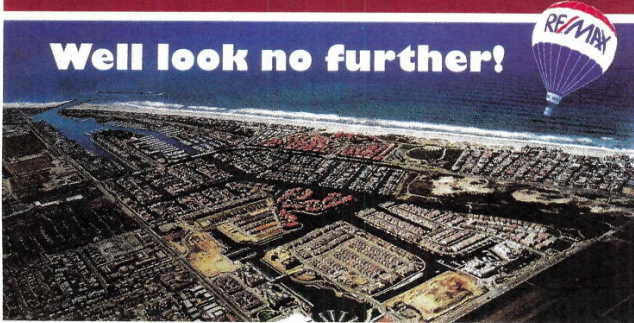
