PCYF had another good year. We had a great staff of instructors, and the four sessions were full of enthusiastic young sailors. The June sessions were a little chilly, but the kids didn't seem to notice.

We try to make our session fees reasonable and thus strive to reach a balance of being affordable as well as keeping the sessions full. As a result, the fees paid do not cover the total cost of running the program. Hence, we rely on contributions and grants to cover the deficit. Unfortunately, we end each season owing PCYC a substantial amount of money until we are able to build up our account through contributions and other sources of funds. It is the objective of the PCYF Board to "get ahead of the curve" and not end up each season requiring PCYC to provide interim funding by having funds to cover most of the season before it starts. This is a more prudent way to run our business. It is doubtful that we can accomplish this objective in one year, but we need to get started. If you are considering any tax-deductible charitable giving before year end, helping PCYF with our youth sailing program is a great cause.
