# Fleet Captain Sail - Joe Vetrano



First of all, I'd like to thank Kevin Dickman for the great job he has done over the years as Fleet Captain Sail. He has worked tirelessly to promote the PCYC sail and racing program, especially the annual McNish Classic. I had often raced against Kevin, some 20 odd years ago, and can attest to his competitive spirit. Kevin has done a first-class job for PCYC and I wish him and Brenda well in Oregon.

The 41st Annual McNish Classic was held on July 28th. Fourteen wooden boats from San Diego to Santa Barbara participated. The weekend started off with a hosted taco bar the night before the race, and there was a great turnout of racers and club members! Jan Losey and crew handled the tee-shirt sales.

The wind was light the morning of the race, but at 11:30 AM the breeze finally arrived and the first boat (OURN a 21' sloop) started at noon. This race is a reverse handicap, meaning that the slowest boat starts first and the fastest boat starts last. If handicaps are realistic and the boats are sailed well, all sailboats should cross the finish line at approximately the same time. The last boat to start was Miramar, at 1:28 PM.

In spite of light winds, Sally a 59' sloop captained by C.F. Kohler was first to finish at 4:03 pm. She was followed 6 minutes later by Silvan a 30' cutter with Dan Isreal at the helm. Thirty seconds later the 59' schooner Rose of Shannon driven by Wayne Elle crossed the line. Dick McNish's Cherrio II ended up 4th in their class. Walter Russakoff's Vignette II also ended fourth in their class.

Each year a couple of new entries show up to race. My goal is to get a bigger fleet of wooden boats for next year's McNish Classic.

I'd like to thank my race committee crew: Don Yokaitis, who provided his power boat, his daughter Marlana, Catherine French, and Jan Losey. They all contributed to a smooth running race, especially the finish line where boats are often less than a minute apart. Special thanks to Dick McNish who provided all the take-home trophies.
